The November 18th meeting of the KHS Tiger Band Boosters was called to order by President Stacey Kremper at 7:15pm.

I. Welcome

II. Committee Reports

1. Alertify: Jackie Lawson/Seda Caffery – Slows down during the winter months. We are getting all messages out. Please contact Jackie if you are not getting the information. Information is also posted on Facebook. Will need another person to take over with Jackie because she is a senior mom.
2. Uniforms: Stacie Kremper – No report. We are done with uniforms until March.
3. Color Guard: Michele Milgrim/Denise Breihaupt – Looking for a new venue for practice.
4. Ways and Means: Robyn Murray – can shake went well. Had 85 students. All showed up. We raised \$3,973.96 with two less venues. Overall it was wonderful. We are booking another one next November. Bowling for the band made \$391 including bake sale. Last thing is our sheet for fundraising opportunities. Many of them are run by Senior moms. We need more people to help take over some of the events. We don't have info on Soup sales. Wreath sale ends tonight. Will have a table for that at the Pops concert tomorrow.

NOTE: Tomorrow is the pops concert. We do a 50/50 at the concert. Stacey is doing recording so she is looking for volunteers to help. We usually make around \$400...

7. Yearbook: Denise Breihaupt – she will be at the pops concert tomorrow to collect slips. They always sell out. Thank you to Val for the incredible pictures. We will miss you next year.
8. Chaperones: Denise Breihaupt/ Leslea Mendrysa – just want to say thank you to all chaperones. Had a great time this year. Anyone who has chaperone badges please send them back. If you have applied to tier 2 or tier 3 approval, you are getting approved.
9. Website: Dave Sahloff – it is out there. Looking good!
10. Publicity: Tara Rogerson – thank you! Beautiful job this year.
11. NYSSMA/Play: Stacie Kremper – play is coming up in March 15th (dress rehearsal) 16, 17, 19. We were offered several years ago, the snack concessions and it has turned into a cash cow for us. You can only sell during the 15 minute intermission. We often make \$1800 selling popcorn, candy, baked goods and water.

Stacie is looking for someone to help out to take over next year. If someone doesn't take it over, we have to give it back to the coir. NYSSMA is not until April.

12. Fall Fanfare: Stacie Kremper/ Robyn Murray – Great weather! The bands were all happy and did a fabulous job. Total profits \$11,128 (better than last year). Thank you everyone for all your help. 13. Band Banquet: we are going to be looking at several different places. The date we have is June 10.

- IV. **New Business** – quad drums fell apart on trip to Syracuse. We addressed in Exec. Mr. Garner will give us a quote next month and we can vote next month. \$2880 includes harnesses, stands and quads.

Citrus – we have 2 orders right now. It is due Friday. It all goes into their personal accounts. We are looking at a senior trip. We are thinking of an extra day at Syracuse. We need NYSSMA music and registration. These things can come out the kids account. The citrus sells itself.

Friday – area all state, in Suffern New York. The kids are going down and back on a bus on Friday. Saturday they take a bus down there and come back on their own.

NYSBDA – honors band for kids who did not make Allstate but had a high score. It is a weekend in Syracuse. The kids have a great time. It is a \$280 fee and the booster club payed for half. This year we have 9 that made it. It is the next step below All State. Thank you.

What a season! A rejuvenating season. We are close to music for next year and Drumline will be chosen by the middle of December. We couldn't do this without your help. Working with the band and the boosters has been extremely rewarding. It is real teamwork. Giant thank you.
