Shifts are Friday 3:16-6:00, next shift 6:30 – 9:30 or so. Saturday 8:15 to Noon and then 12:15 to 4. Email Mr. Garner if interested (need 2 slots for early Friday, 1 for Friday night, 2 Saturday morning, 4 Saturday afternoon – not including Alumni/Seniors scoring).

We also need help with food concessions. NYSSMA reimburses for the students who work to get a meal. Also need volunteers to help sell concessions in the cafeteria. 2 Shifts on Friday and 3 shifts on Saturday. Also want to set up a snack bar down by Field House. Cafeteria volunteers needed Friday 3-6, then 6-9 Dinner and cleanup; Saturday 8 – 11, 11-2 lunch shift and 2 – 5 cleanup shift. Will need baked goods. Kids will bring home a letter where each section brings another item for concessions. We need baked goods. Bring them Friday night to the Cafeteria.
